Learning Objective/ Timeline	What product could student's access to accomplish the learning objective within the specified timeline?	What technology tool could be used to meet the objective within the timeline?	What additional 'training' do the students need to use the program?
Explore Career opportunities; 5 class periods	Students will create a video to report the career opportunity that most interests them. They will write the dialogue to include career specific information and then share their videos with the class.	xtranormal.com	20 minute tutorial about xtranormal.com will be needed for students to learn how to use the program. This will be taught after 1 day of research. Students will peer review and help their classmates utilize xtranormal.com
Review for final exam; 2 class periods	Students will not create anything; they will use technology to study.	Quia.com	10 review activities will be created to review the topics covered throughout the semester; no additional training to play the review activities.
Learn the 7 functions of marketing; 3 class periods	Students will work in groups of 2-3 to create a collaborative report using a wiki about their assigned function of marketing; then report to the class. Classmates will be able to view everyone's wiki, but will not be able to edit the work of other groups.	Pbworks.com	The wiki program is similar to any text editing software; allow ½ class period for students to familiarize themselves with the collaborative nature of the wiki.
