In English, adjectives usually come *before* the noun that they modify:

-The ugly duckling.

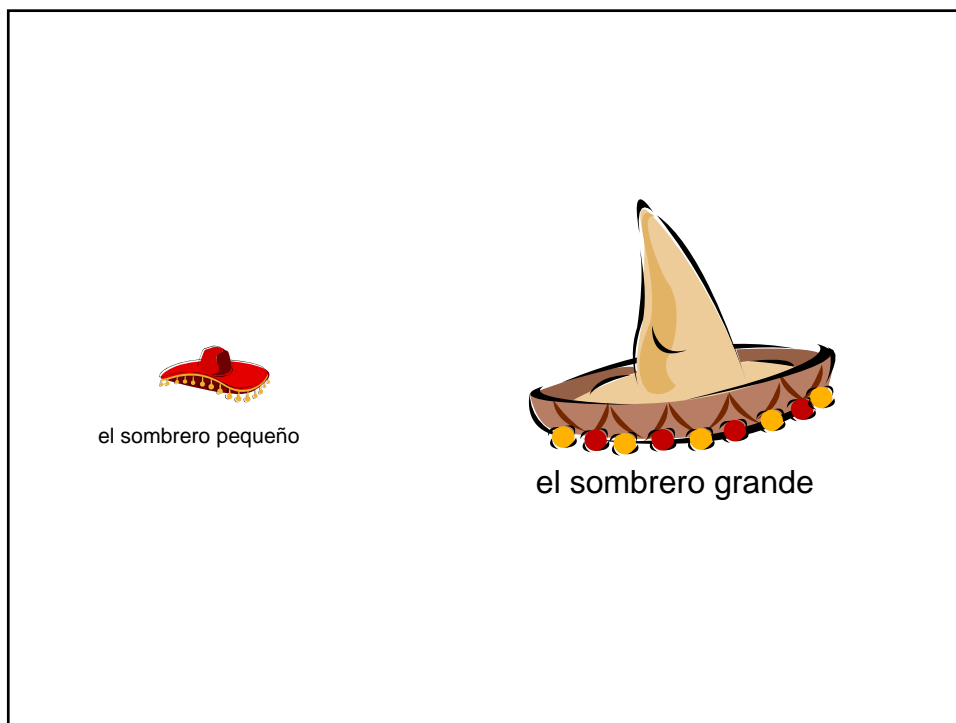
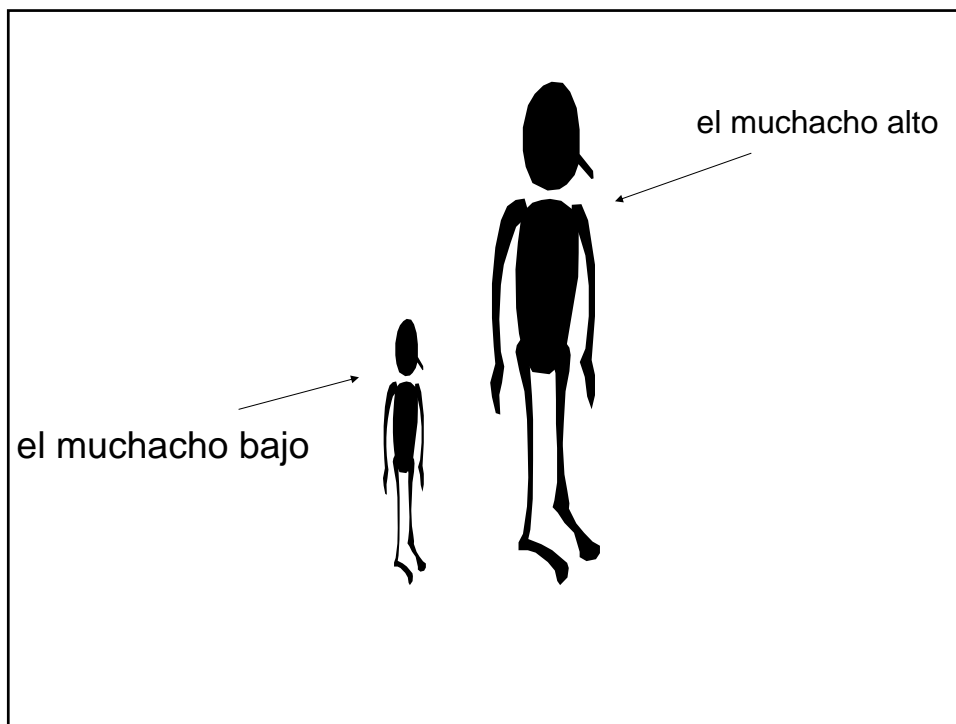
-The Super Bowl.

In Spanish, the adjectives usually come *after* the noun that they modify:

-El muchacho alto.

-La muchacha simpática.

In Spanish, most adjectives take the gender of the noun that they modify. If a regular adjective modifies a masculine noun, it will end with \_\_\_\_\_. If a regular adjective modifies a feminine noun, it will end with \_\_\_\_\_.
