

**Student Clues**

**Directions: Cut along the dotted lines and give the clues to the students.**

-----  
**T1 Starting clue** – Your starting point is the most southern province of Spain. The *Tumba Cista Sillares* is located here. It contains the remains of a fully intact skeleton in a museum named after the city.

**T1 Clue 2** – The *Magna Hispalensis*, is the second largest church after the Basilica in the Vatican, Rome. Its origins date back to the 12th century and can be found in your next destination.

**T1 Clue 3** – La Mesquita is located in your next destination. You can also explore the Sierra Morena in the north and the Campiña (farmlands) in the south, separated by the River Guadalquivir.

**T1 Clue 4** – The Alhambra is located in your next destination. This city was also the last city of Moorish rule to be conquered by the King and Queen of Spain in 1492.

**T1 Clue 5**– El Botín is the oldest restaurant in the world according to the Guinness World Book of Records.

**T1 Clue 6** –The Mestalla stadium is the location of many soccer games in Spain and was opened here in 1923.

**T1 Clue 7** – The famous “El Puerto Olímpico” is located in your next destination. BMX bicycle games were held here.

**T1 Clue 8** – The famous Spanish painter, Francisco Goya, has several paintings and drawings in the local Museum on the Plaza de los Sitos at your next destination.

**T1 Clue 9** – Your final destination is where the running of the bulls takes place. You must arrive there by 7:00 am to get a good spot in the race. The starting cannon goes off an hour later at 8:00 and it will cost you 1.500 pesetas to get into the actual bull ring if you want to watch the bull fight.

**T2 Starting clue** – The oldest university in Spain is located in the city of your next destination

**T2 Clue 2** – The famous *Museo del Prado* is located in the city of your next destination.

**T2 Clue 3** – Famous works of the artist El Greco are housed in the El Greco Museum in the city of your next destination.

**T2 Clue 4** – You may have to do some backtracking to get to your next destination. It is the capital city of Spain.

**T2 Clue 5** – Roman aquaducts and the Alcazar castle can still be admired in the city of your next destination. Train ticket cost from Madrid to Segovia = 940 pts.

**T2 Clue 6** – Yet again, you must backtrack to your previous destination in order to proceed on your trip.

**T2 Clue 7** – The *Sierra de Grazalema* natural park is located in your next destination. The area is famous for its spectacular limestone cliffs and landscape of gullies, caverns and gorges, the most spectacular being La Verde, with rocky walls that rises almost vertically for 400 meters.

**T2 Clue 8** – The city of your next destination is the capital of the Andalucía region. Here, you can find *La Torre Del Oro*, or the Tower of Gold (not really made of gold), build by the Arabs almost 1,000 years ago.

**T2 Clue 9** – This city was conquered by Muslims in the year 711 AD. This city's best-known monumental building is the Mosque or Mezquita. It is situated on the banks of the Guadalquivir River in the Jewish Quarter. It symbolizes all the grandeur and power of the city under Arab rule by the Omeya dynasty, and is considered by some the most significant Arabic monument in the western world.

**T2 Clue 10** – The *Palacio Real*, Royal Palace, is an impressive example of the baroque style. Charles III was, in 1714, the first king to have his residence here.

**T2 Clue 11** – An international film festival is held here every year. Also, in this city is located the *Palacio de los Viveros*, where the Reyes Católicos (Catholic Kings) were married.

**T2 Clue 12** – All Honda imports into Spain go through a port in the city of your next destination.

---

**T2 Clue 13** – Your final destination is where the running of the bulls takes place. You must arrive there by 7:00 am to get a good spot in the race. The starting cannon goes off an hour later at 8:00 and it will cost you 1500 pesetas to get into the actual bull ring if you want to watch the bull fight.

---

(There is no train schedule from Santander to Pamplona. The students must rent a car and drive.)

Santander to Pamplona is 157 miles. How long would it take if you drove 78 miles per hour? Would you make it to the running of the bulls on time?

Rental car cost from Santander to Pamplona = 5.456 pts.
