

## Librito de “la voz pasiva con se”

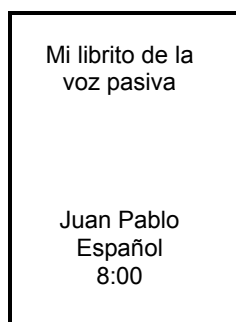
**Assignment:** Using the passive voice with the pronoun **se**, students will write and illustrate a “librito” (little book) for activities that are and are not done around the classroom.

**Materials:** Markers, coloring pencils, or crayons  
Magazines, glue or tape, and scissors  
Colored construction paper  
Stapler  
Classroom vocabulary sheet

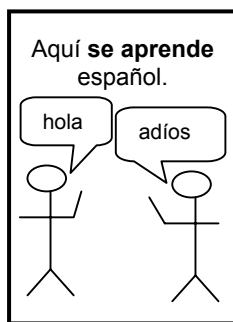
**Grade:** The librito de “la voz pasiva” will be worth a total of 50 points.

### Procedure:

1. Write a rough draft of your sentences on lined paper.
2. Write six sentences describing what activities are and are not done around the classroom using the passive voice with the pronoun **se** and words from the classroom vocabulary sheet.
  - A. The first three sentences will describe what activities are done around the classroom.
  - B. The last three sentences will describe what activities are not done around the classroom.
3. When you have your sentences written, check your grammar and spelling. When you have checked your own grammar and spelling switch your paper with another student and proofread each other’s sentences.
4. Once you have your sentences proofread, you are ready to write your sentences in the librito.
5. To make your librito you will need two pieces of 8 ½” x 11” construction paper of any color. Fold the construction paper in half the short way to make a 5 ½” x 8 ½” booklet.
6. Staple your librito at the seam so that it opens like a book and doesn’t fall apart.
7. You will need to make a title page. The title page should have the title Mi librito de la voz pasiva at the top. It should also include your name, subject, and class hour at the bottom.
8. You will write one sentence per page.
9. You will illustrate each sentence using the markers, coloring pencils, or crayons. You may also trace or cut out pictures from a magazine if you choose. Make sure your picture illustrates the sentence. For example, If you write Spanish is learned here, you might draw a picture of students speaking Spanish. (You may not use these examples in your librito.)
