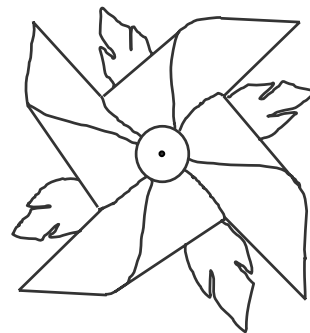


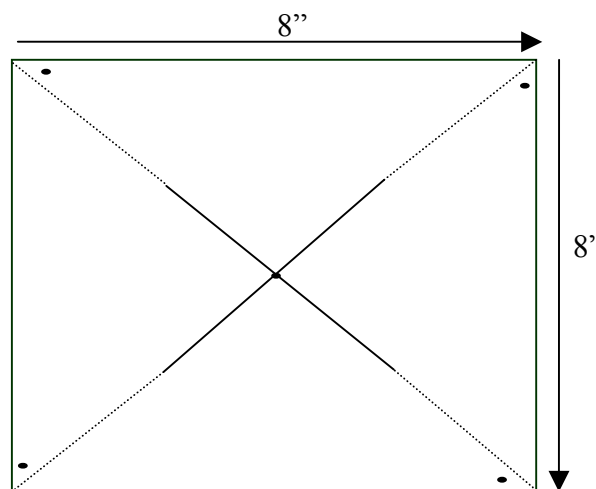
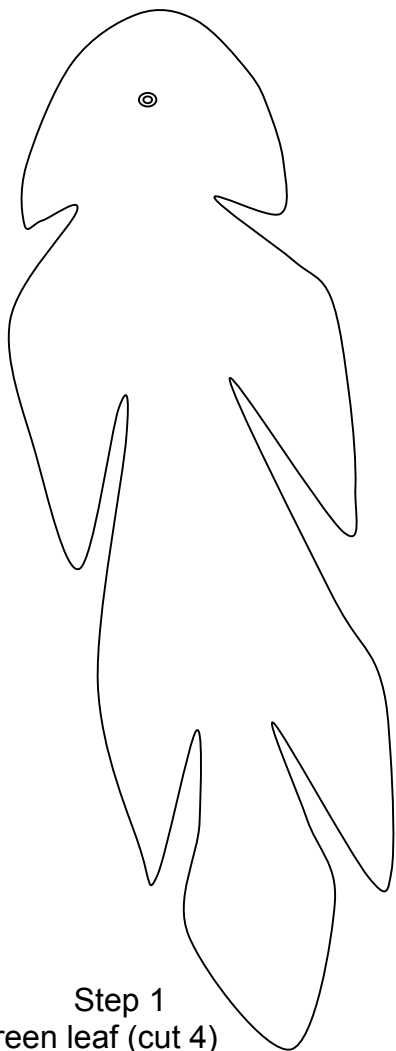
The Poinsettia Pinwheel Project

Materials: Red, green, and yellow construction paper
Pencil or pen
Scissors
Ruler
1 Brad
(Optional – Popsicle stick and glue or tape.)

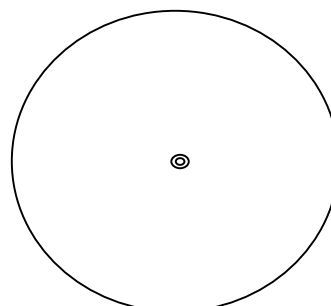


Directions:

1. Using the leaf cut-out and green construction paper, cut out four green leaves.
2. With the red construction paper, measure and cut one eight-inch square.
3. Using the ruler, draw a dotted line diagonally across the square, corner to corner.
4. Add five black dots, a dot in the center and a dot in each corner. See picture below.
5. Cut the dotted lines approximately 4 inches from the corners.
6. Using yellow construction paper, cut out center circle.
7. Fold the corners with dots to the center dot.
8. Using the brad, fasten the poinsettia together.
9. The order you put it together will be the yellow center on top, the red poinsettia in the middle, and the four green leaves on the bottom.
10. (Optional step) Glue or tape the Popsicle stick to the back of the Poinsettia Pinwheel.
