NOTE: Teachers, because student names will vary in length, it is necessary to grade on a percentage basis. For example, if Robert has used eight adjectives in his description, he has the possibility of getting eight correct. If he misses two, his score for Section 1 will be 6 correct, divided by 8 possible, multiplied by 25. ($6 \div 8 = \frac{3}{4}$; $\frac{3}{4} \times 25 = 18.75$.) You may want to round up.
