

El tiempo

Description: Students will create their own weather report in Spanish.

Materials:

- One piece of white paper and a piece of notebook paper **OR** two pieces of notebook paper
- Markers/Crayons (**YOU MAY NOT USE PEN OR PENCIL!!!!**)
- Internet access
- Maps of Spain and Central/South America (pgs. 463-365 en tu libro)

Procedure: You will create a weather report for a Hispanic country. You will write a weather report on a piece of notebook paper for **3 cities*** in the country you have chosen.

1) Your report must include the following:

- a) Greeting
- b) Introduction of self
- c) The date (Hoy es...)
- d) The weather forecast for **today** using 2 different weather expressions.
 - Ejemplo: Hoy hace viento y está lloviendo en Madrid. (you may not use this example)
- f) The temperature for today.

All of this must be done in Spanish!

2) You will pick **three cities** from the maps given to you. After you have chosen them, you will go to a weather Web site and look up the forecast. Choose one of the following weather Web sites:

- <http://weather.yahoo.com/>
- <http://www.cnn.com/WEATHER/>

3) You will draw the country on your piece of white paper/ notebook paper. Correctly label the cities you have chosen on the drawing. This will be your "weather map." Using your creativity, draw the type of weather it will be for today and tomorrow by your city. Write the temperature beside your city as well in Spanish. Turn in when finished.

*There are some countries that don't have 3 cities labeled. Pick one that has at least 3 cities.
