

Las emociones

Description: Students will practice using the emotion expressions in Spanish.

Materials:

- Camera (Polaroid or Snapshot)
- Film
- Las emociones vocabulary list

Procedure:

Instructors:

1. Cut up the words from the vocabulary list into strips. Put into a hat or a bowl.
2. Have each of the students draw one or more of the emotion expressions out of the hat or bowl.
3. Take each student's picture acting out the emotion that is on his or her strip of paper.
4. Develop the film.
5. Hand out the developed pictures randomly to the students. Don't give the students his/her own picture.
6. Have the students write the emotion expression on the back in both English and Spanish. The students should use the verb "estar" when writing their sentence in Spanish.
 - a. Ejemplo: Ana está enojada.
 - b. Example: Ana is angry.

Students:

1. Draw an emotion out of the hat or bowl.
2. You will act out the emotion that is on the strip of paper you drew out of the bowl or hat. Be dramatic and exaggerate your emotion! Your classmates need to be able to tell what emotion it is just by looking at the picture!
3. When you receive a developed picture from your instructor, write one sentence in Spanish and one in English describing the emotion. The sentences need to be written on the back of the picture. You need to use the verb "estar" when writing your sentence in Spanish.
 - a. Ejemplo: Ana está enojada.
 - b. Example: Ana is angry.
