Quick Facts

Since August 2001

- The DLC was the first distance-learning provider to deliver Spanish language content correlated to the Arkansas curriculum frameworks over the Compressed Interactive Video (CIV) network
- The DLC was the first distance-learning provider to successfully deliver CPEP content over the CIV network to assist students in improving their ACT scores
- The DLC was awarded the Bronze award as a distance-learning provider in May 2007 and April 2008 by the United States Distance Learning Association
- Miss Cynthia Green was awarded the Gold award in April 2008 for Excellence in Teaching by the United States Distance Learning Association
- The number of schools receiving content from the DLC has increased 1,460 percent (from 5 schools to 81 schools)
- Of the 76 districts receiving content from the DLC, 41 percent of the districts have from 500 to 999 students and 27 percent of the districts have from 1000 to 1499 students
- The typical district receives 4 classes from the DLC
- Enrollment has increased 2,324 percent (from 112 students to 2,715 students)
- The average passing rate over the past seven years is 95 percent
- The number of CIV Instructional Hours has increased by 1,754.75 percent
- The number of CIV Classes has increased by 4,350 percent
- Fulltime faculty has increased from 7 instructors to 24 instructors
- Twenty-five percent of the instructors have graduate degrees
- 100 percent of the instructors are Highly Qualified
- The ADE DLC offers 23.5 units of the specified 38 units that must be offered yearly
- The ADE DLC offers all of the required Smart Core units except Physical Education and Health
